- 1. The superlatives ("all" >50Xs)
- 2. A lofty theme: God is working in this world through His church to accomplish His great purposes and will (1:10)
- 3. The glorious and mysterious church comprising both Jews and Gentiles

- 4. Unspeakable and incomprehensible blessings in Christ
- 5. Great dispensational realities reveal God's master plan for the ages.
- 6. Magnificent glory
- 7. The works of the Holy Spirit

- 8. The believer's peace
- 9. Heavenly harmony through unity in the Body of Christ
- 10. Spiritual leaders as God's gift to the church
- 11. The blessing of spiritual transformation

- 13. The blessing of imitating Christ
- 14. The blessing of portraying Christ in my marriage
- 15. Experiencing Christ in my home
