- B. My words are to be gracious and edifying *Prov 10:21; James 1:19, 26;*
- C. A Graceless heart leads to gossip and flattery and is a destroyer
- 1 Tim 5:11-13; Prov 11:13; 18:8; 20:19;26: 20,22; Eph 4:25
- D. Not speaking the truth to one another is loveless & hateful (*Lev 19:17*)
- E. Christ the way to restore our tongues & speech (*Isa50: 4; Jhn 12:49,50*)

  IV. Are My Words, Words of Life or Are they Words of Death?
- If we are liars and flatterers we are of Satan (John 8:44)
- God wants us to speak truth even when it is hard (*Prov 17:27; 25:11*)
