II. GOD'S COMMAND

- A. When we worship Him according to His glory: 1 Tim. 1:17; 6:15-16
 - 1. Worship Him *in spirit* as He is an infinite Spirit (John 4:23-24)
 - 2. Worship Me *in truth*: in an appropriate reflection of His character a. Is our mental image of God Biblically accurate? (Ps. 50:21)
 - b. Is our mental image according to God's sermon about God (Ex. 34:6
 - c. Where will a misrepresentation of God lead to?
 - 3. Worship Me in beauty of holiness (Ps. 29:2; 96:9)
 - a. refers to the acts of approach and worship in the temple (Ps. 50:1-2)
 - Calvin: The beauty of the temple is an expression intended to beget a reverential view of the temple, that men may approach it with humble fear, instead of rushing without consideration into God's presence. The clause which follows in the verse is inserted for the same purpose tremble before his face, intimating that we should prostrate ourselves as suppliants before him when we consider his awful majesty
 - John Gill: In this and the three preceding verses there is a manifest allusion to the form of addresses made to kings in the eastern nations; who being arrayed, and seated in a majestic manner, with all the marks of royal honour and dignity about them, whom their subjects approach with ascriptions of glory to them; bringing presents in their hands, and bowing down to the ground before them, as the word for "worship" signifies; expressing the utmost awe and reverence of them as 'fear before Him, all the earth' indicates!

b. though God looks at the heart, He does look at the outward details He has specified as important: Is. 66:2; Ex. 19:10-13; 17; 1 Sam. 6:6

III. GOD'S WARNING & PROMISE

- A. Gods warning: dishonoring Me is self-destructive
 - 1. God calls the sin against the 1st and 2nd commandment: hating Him!
 - 2. God warns: I will leave you to the 3rd and 4th generation
- B. God's promise: those that honor Me, I will honor for a thousand: Deut. 7:9
 - 1. Take note of the Gospel wording of His law: show mercy ...!

Application: We need to examine our worship at every level?

- A. Is our 'worship-details' according to the God-given will to honor Him?
 - 1. God is not against appropriate *cultural traditions* as long as they *done* decently and in order while they remain *traditions*
 - 2. Paul's principles of *conduct* is our guidance: 1 Cor. 6:12; 10:23
 a. there is 'Christian freedom' in things God has not specified in worship
 - 3. Let us all do some *soul searching* about Jesus' rebuke of Jewish church: Mark 7:6-13

Serve the LORD with gladness;

Serve the LORD with fear,

Let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear.
