Gentile Tug of War (part 3) Daniel 11:1-20

I. <u>PERSIA</u>: "kings...in Persia" (vv.1-2)

A. Purpose: "an encouragement and a protection" (v.1)

B. Prominence: "three more kings...then a fourth" (v.2)

II. <u>GREECE</u>: "a mighty king...uprooted" (vv.3-4)

A. Dominant: "a mighty king...with great authority" (v.3)

B. Divided: "kingdom...broken up/parceled out" (v.4)

III. <u>EGYPT/SYRIA</u>: "the south...the north" (vv.5-20)

A. Egypt: "king of the South" (vv.5-8)

- 1. South Dominates: "will grow strong...great dominion" (v.5)
- 2. South Alliance: "they will form an alliance" (v.6)
- 3. South Victory: "he will take into captivity" (vv.7-8)

B. Syria: "king of the North" (vv.9-20)

- 1. North Revenge: "one of them will...wage war" (vv.9-10)
- 2. South Retaliates: "the king...will be enraged" (vv.11-12)
- North Returns: "the king...will do as he pleases" (vv.13-20)
 a. Fighters: "the violent ones among your people" (vv.13-15)
 - b. Fear: "he will also stay...in the Beautiful land" (vv.16-20)
