I Text:

Il Doctrine: The modern Christian Church has been teaching a disrespectful message based on "cheap grace." If you truly love and respect your Father in heaven, you will behave like you believe. Christians who are walking in the Spirit will want to learn about the God they serve through his Word. Those who have truly been reconciled to God and know his grace will have joy and peace in their hearts. Our worship of God through Christ is through radical obedience, and not radical grace.

- 1) The modern Christian Church has been teaching a disrespectful message based on "cheap grace." People in the Church are told God loves and saves them, without even knowing what they are saved from. Everyone knows the doctrine of grace, but very few are instructed in the law of God. - 3) Our worship of God through Christ is through radical obedience, and not radical grace. (1Peter 2:3; Psalm 34; Hebrews 13:20-24)
