Healing the Wounded Spirit Proverbs 18:14 Proverbs: God's Wisdom Handbook, part 17 July 24, 2022

Prov.18:14; The spirit of a man will sustain his infirmity; but a wounded spirit who can bear?

Prov.15:13; A merry heart maketh a cheerful countenance; but by sorrow of the heart the spirit is broken.

Prov.17:22; A merry heart doeth good *like* a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones.

Proverbs 12:25; Heaviness in the heart of man maketh it stoop: but a good word maketh it glad.

Prov.13:12; Hope deferred maketh the heart sick; but when the desire cometh it is a tree of life

Prov. 15:4; A wholesome tongue is a tree of life; but perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit.

Prov.15:15; All the days of the afflicted *are* evil: but he that is of a merry heart *hath* a continual feast.

• We are living through an epidemic of wounded spirits and broken hearts!

 It is vitally important to heal a wounded spirit, because this becomes a crushing weight to any man.

Proverbs 18:14; The spirit of a man will sustain his infirmity; but a wounded spirit who can bear?

- A wounded spirit is **smashed to pieces**, **weighed down in fear**, **crippled with disappointment**, and **destroyed like an earthquake in the soul** (Prov. 15:13,12:25, 13:12, 15:4)
- Because God says we can have a "merry heart," here are five ways He heals the Wounded Spirit
- Prov.15:15; He that is of a merry heart hath a continual feast.

1. **Reject** "when and then" thinking: believe you can rejoice in Christ now!

2. Desire First who can never be lost: God Himself!

Prov.13:12; Hope deferred maketh the heart sick; but when the desire cometh it is a tree of life. (See Isaiah 26:8-9)

3. Fill _

Proverbs 12:25; Heaviness in the heart of man maketh it stoop: but a good word maketh it glad. (See Jeremiah 17: 7, 8)

4. Speak _____

Prov. 15:4; A wholesome (healthy) tongue is a tree of life; but perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit.

Prov.18:21; Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

Prov.12:18; There is that speaketh like the piercings of a sword: but the tongue of the wise is health.

Prov.16:24; Pleasant words *are as* an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.

5. Rest _

Prov.18:14; The spirit of a man will sustain his infirmity; but a wounded spirit who can bear?
