### Cave Men In The Bible - 07/11/21

**TEXT- 1 Ki 19:1-9** And he came thither unto a cave, and lodged there; and, behold, the word of the LORD came to him, and he said unto him, What doest thou here, Elijah?

INTRO – Our modern educators have erroneously suggested that modern man descended from cave men of the past. The Bible does not use the term *caveman* or *Neanderthals*. So, according to the Bible there is no such thing as "prehistoric" man. The Bible gives no indication that Adam and Eve accidentally evolved from lower life forms.

Unfortunately, the popular mainstream view promotes this idea that man and ape both evolved from the same ancestor. Caves were used as a place to escape or hide. They were never a superior place to live.

Elijah was running from the queen

David hiding from the Philistines and from King Saul

Lot hid from the destruction of Sodom

Sara, Abraham, Isaac, Rebekah and Lea were all buried in the Cave Machpelah.

Five kings of Canaan were trapped and later killed by Joshua in the Cave Makkedah

Caves were a place for the dead not he living.

1 Kings 19:9 And he came thither unto a cave, and lodged there; and, behold, the word of the LORD came to him, and he said unto him, What doest thou here, Elijah?

**Exo 17:6** Behold, I will stand before thee there upon the rock in Horeb; and thou shalt smite the rock, and there shall come water out of it, that the people may drink. And Moses did so in the sight of the elders of Israel.
