# This Sunday at CMPC...

This Sunday Pastor John continues our new series The Future is as Bright as the Promises of God by looking at Who is CMPC? From Isaiah 6.1-8, along with I Peter 2.9-10. We will have a long awaited privilege at the 11am service of giving the sacrament of covenant baptism to Nathan and Kasia Tunnell's daughter, Amelia Rose. We have been praying for her for so long... what a joyous time in the life of the church! It will also be a very special Sunday as we receive new members into the CMPC family. Then on Sunday evening at Summer in the SON Pastor John will be looking at Genesis 45 and It's Me- Joseph! in our series Joseph: When Dreams Come True. The food treat this Sunday is ice cream sundaes.

Sunday's hymns tie into our Isaiah passage and the response it demands. We will gather with Jack Haryford's 1980 classic, Majesty, which focuses on Jesus. Our hymn of praise will be another classic hymn, Holy! Holy! Holy! Reginald Heber's early 19<sup>th</sup> century hymn is actually drawn from our text and then Revelation 4.1-11. Heber was then drawn to missions and went to Calcutta, India, where he died 3 years later at the age of 43. His widow actually found this hymn in his papers after he died, and the words were not put to music until John Dykes in 1861. The hymn quickly became widely used in the church. The famed poet Alfred Lord Tennyson considered it the world's greatest hymn. For our hymn of testimony we turn to a recent hymn from 2020 by the team of Keith Getty, Matt Boswell, Jordan Kauflin, Matt Merker and Matt Papa, Christ Our Hope in Life and Death. Our hymn of response is a prayer called Macedonia; this was a mid-20<sup>th</sup> century hymn from the pen of Anne Ortlund.
