I. TRUE WORSHIP BEGINS WITH PRAISE

Psalm 100:1-4

- A. Praise is recalling God's **mighty acts**.
- B. Praise is reciting the marvelous aspects of God's **character**.
- C. Praise is **thanking** Him for His actions.

II. TRUE WORSHIP IS RELATIONAL

1 Chronicles 16:28-29

- A. The wrong question is, "How do **I like** to worship?"
- B. The right question is, "How does **God like** to be worshipped?"

John 4:21-24; Zephaniah 3:17

III. TRUE WORSHIP IS AT THE FEET OF JESUS

Luke 10:39; John 11:32; John 12:3

In Luke 10, she found her **BLESSING** at His feet.
In John 11, she brought her **BURDEN** to His feet.
In John 12, she gave her **BEST** at His feet.

I want to know Christ and the power of his resurrection and the fellowship of sharing in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death. Philippians 3:10

A. She found her blessing at His feet.

- 1. She **stopped**
- 2. She **listened**

B. She brought her burden to His feet.

There is a difference between **throwing** your burdens at Jesus' **face** and **laying** your burdens at Jesus' **feet**.

C. She gave her best at His feet.
