The Heidelberg Catechism

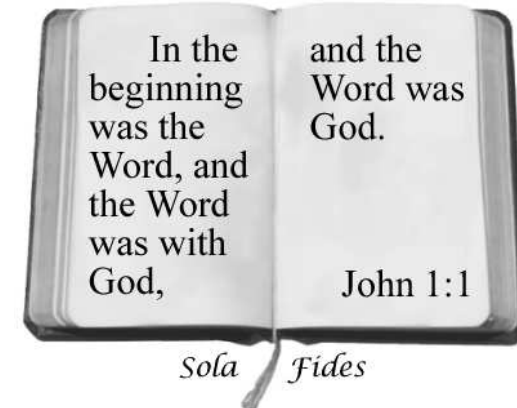
