## I. Jesus Travels to Bethany & Eats with Lazarus. (1-2)

This supper probably took place in the house of Simon the Leper as recorded in <u>Matthew</u> <u>26:6-13</u> and <u>Mark 14:3-9</u>. However, some think it was a separate incident and happened at the home of Lazarus, Marry and Martha.

## **APPLICATION QUESTIONS**

FOR WEDNESDAY NIGHT

- 1. Marry, Martha and Lazarus were Jesus' good friends. Why do you think He made it a point to visit with them before His crucifixion at Passover?
- 2. How do you think the Jews felt seeing Lazarus (who had been dead) sit and eat with Jesus?
- 3. Why did Mary use "very costly" ointment to anoint Jesus? What did Jesus mean in verse 7?
- 4. Does verse 8 indicate that we should not help the poor? What does it mean?
- 5. Judas Iscariot was a thief (vs. 6) but had all the disciples tricked into thinking he was a good and trustworthy person who cared for the poor. (Cf. Matthew 26:8-9). Why is it easy for us to be duped by people at church?

- 6. Why were the chief priests so focused on putting Lazarus to death? (vs. 10) Would doing that have solved their problems?
- 7. How was prophecy fulfilled through the wicked actions of the Jewish religious leaders?
- 8. Can you think of any times in your own life when God brought good out of evil?
