## Introduction:

- 1) Within the theological realm there is a word which you will hear tossed around quite a bit, the word, "orthodox."
- **2)** In the Greek language it is a compound word, the first part being **"ortho,"** which literally **means straight.** You see it in the word, "Orthopedic," which describes a doctor who sets bones straight.
- The second word comes to us from the root word "dokeo," which primarily means to believe or think.
- **4)** So literally, **orthodox** means <u>to think or believe straight.</u> We use it to describe **straight thinking or sound doctrine**, as opposed to twisted or unsound doctrine.
