INTRODUCTION: DEDICATION

True dedication is revealed only after it begins to cost you something.

Every Christian should understand that to follow Christ means we will suffer.

1 Peter 2:21

For you have been called for this purpose, since Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example for you to follow in His steps...

There is one verb given in Hebrews 12:1-2 and it is a command. It is the command you need to obey to live out your destiny as the modern version of those Old Testament heroes. The command is run.

Race:
