 - A) Three things implied in thirsting.
 1. The gift of the water is free.
 2. The human soul has thirst.
 3. What Jesus offers is satisfying.
 - B) Three observations about coming to Jesus to drink. (John 7:37-38)
 1. Jesus is what we drink. (John 6:35)
 2. The soul can drink.
 3. This coming and drinking are what it means to believe on Jesus.
(John 1:12)
 - C) The rivers that flow from the soul. (John 7:38)
 - D) The Spirit of the glorified Jesus.
(John 7:39; 14:16-17; Romans 8:9-10)
 - E) The witness of scripture to the plans of God.
