Text: Hebrews 12:14-15

Theme: Keys to escaping the trap of bitterness.

when offended?

Examples: Ahasuerus and Haman vs David and Joseph

**Gal 6:1 Brethren**, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, **RESTORE** such an one in the spirit of meekness; **considering thyself**, **lest thou also be tempted**.

So you are hurt and your pride is exposed – how are you going to escape bitterness?

Your temptation will be

To punish them for what they have done to you.

To judge them for how they have treated you

I. Your escape – the pursuit of peace (v. 14)

II. Your escape – the grace of God (v. 15)

The two worst plagues of the church: the absence of forgiveness, and the presence of bitterness. The two are connected!

Bitterness is like drinking poison and hoping it kills the one you hate
