## INTRODUCTION:

**EPHESIANS 5:15** 

BE CAREFUL HOW YOU USE <u>TIME</u> (REDEEM YOUR TIME (V. 16)

Cp. Col. 4:5 - "Walk in wisdom toward then that are without, redeeming the time."

- a. KNOW ITS WORTH.
  - 1. Time is valuable (precious)
  - 2. Time is irreplaceable.
- b. KNOW ITS <u>UNCERTAINTY</u>
  "Days are evil" (wicked)

See: Psalm 90

\*Three truths to remember about time from Psalm 90 -

- 1. God is not bound by time (v. 1-6)
- 2. Man's life is short, and sin makes it sorrowful (v. 7-11)
- 3. We need God to give us wisdom to make the most of our lives (v. 12-17)

How to make the most of your life:

- a) Live in light of the Lord's return (v. 13)
- b) Experience the Lord's merciful salvation (v. 14)
- c) Let God bring <u>joy and fulfillment</u> into your life, rather than spending your life trying to find it
- d) Trust God to work in and through your life (v. 16-17)

## **CONCLUSION:** Words of Wisdom regarding our time:

- 1. Wake up out of your spiritual lethargy (Rom. 13:11-14)
- 2. Prioritize your life
  - a. Our # 1 love (Matthew 22:37-40)
  - b. Our # 1 goal (Mt. 6:33)
  - c. Our # 1 job (I Tim. 2:1)
- 3. Make your plans by <u>seeking God's will</u> (Ja. 4:13-15)
- 4. Seek to make every moment count for God (Eph. 5:16)
  - a. Ask God to fill (control) you with His Holy Spirit every day.
  - b. Invest your life in the eternal, not the temporal
  - c. Take advantage of every opportunity to be a blessing
  - d. <u>Schedule</u> your time and <u>discipline</u> your life
  - e. Live each day as if it were your <u>last</u>
