

Micah 4 **the Lord shall Rule** (when He returns)

Wednesday

This chapter shows how the Messiah shall rule when He returns at the second coming in verses 1-7 & 8b - 13. { A brief glimpse of His first coming is found in verse 8a. }

note : **Micah 4:1-4 = Isaiah 2:1-4**

v 1 when: *in the last days* doct: **Job 24:1 2 Peter 3:8 Heb 1:2**
hist: **1 Cor 10:32**
spir: **2 Tim 3:1-4 2 Peter 3:3**

v 2 where: *Mt. Zion ... Jerusalem ... exalted above the hills* **Zechariah 14:10**

v 3 how: reprove - **Psalm 9:5**
reformation ~ **Hebrews 9:10**
peace - *neither .. war any more* **Zechariaiah 9:10**

v 4 what: provision ~ **1 Kings 4:25**
security - **Isaiah 54:14**

v 5 loyalty - to local leaders chosen by the Lord
god - **John 10:34-5, Psalm 82:6, Exodus 8:1**
the name of his god - **Deuteronomy 32:8, Numbers 2:2-3**

def : "standard" - *noun* 1. An ensign, a staff with a flag of colors; e.g. the royal standard of England

v 6-7 *her that halteth* = walking in the faith of father Jacob. **Genesis 32:31**
I have afflicted - **Psalm 119:71**

v 8a *tower of the flock* - [1611mr : Or, tower of Edar] **Genesis 35:21**
the first dominion - shall it come = Advent : the 1st coming of the Messiah
hist: Christ came as a lamb - **John 1:29, 1 Peter 1:19**

v 8b - 10

the kingdom shall come to the daughter (v10) = Messiah's return @ the 2nd coming
Babylon ... there ... delivered = a dual reference: both historical & doctrinal, **Rev 17-18**

v 11 *many nations are gathered against thee* - **Luke 21:20**

v 12-13 The Lord will endue the Jews with power to destroy their enemies. **Psalm 149**
