# Discipleship and Baptism: The Baptism of Jesus

Luke 3:15-22



#### **Key Thought**

Baptism is an act of obedience on the part of every disciple in submission to the authority of Jesus Christ.

In other words, Jesus is our supreme and worthy Savior.



## Jesus' baptism highlights His supremacy (3:15-18).

- The Messiah, Jesus, is far superior to any human prophet (3:15-16a).
- The Messiah, Jesus, will institute righteous judgment (3:16b-17).
- The Messiah, Jesus, is the source of truly good news (3:18).

#### Jesus' baptism highlights His sanctity (3:19-20).

 Those who follow the Messiah, Jesus, stand in contrast to society's sins (3:19).

 Those who follow the Messiah, Jesus, may suffer rejection and persecution (3:20).



### Jesus' baptism highlights His authority (3:21-22).

- The Messiah, Jesus, identifies with His people (3:21a).
- The Messiah, Jesus, was endowed with the Holy Spirit (3:21b-22a).
- The Messiah, Jesus, was acknowledged by the Father (3:22b).
