### **Jeremiah 44:1-14**

**I. Doctrine: God’s \_\_\_\_\_ is on *All Idolatry*—no matter how devout and religious it is**

B. Insincere \_\_\_\_\_ does Not Please God,  
(2 Tim. 3:5)
