"Youth pastor apologizes for bikini ban at summer camp...Christian youth pastor Bryce Brewer, 42, apologized for banning bikinis from his summer camp after receiving backlash...the Spokane Valley, Washington, preacher admitted that it was wrong for the 'weight of purity' to be placed on the young girls instead of holding the boys accountable for their actions...'I am sorry that I didn't teach boys to control themselves,' the father of two wrote...'I am sorry that we have deemed a young women's body as something that 'needs to be covered' and let young men's bodies be ok to be seen...'Just learn to control your boys and let women wear what they want to,' wrote one user...'Why are stomachs overtly sexual?' [the pastor] wrote. 'Why is a little cleavage sinful?...'"

"New Princeton Research: People Judge Your Competence Based on Your Clothes in Under 1 Second - it really might be worth spending a bit more on your interview outfit...Even incredibly subtle differences in your clothing can affect how people judge your competence, the series of studies found, and these impressions form in under a second. Your clothes matter a shocking amount...when the Princeton team placed identical faces atop very slightly different outfits, they found people rated their perceived competence much differently...This was true even if the researchers explicitly instructed subjects to ignore clothing...and even if study subjects only viewed the pictures for 130 milliseconds, which is barely long enough to realize you're looking at a face..."

"Most people claim they don't make judgments about people based on appearance, and most people who say that are lying...When the subjects were photographed with any pose and facial expression they wanted - the spontaneous condition - judgments were accurate for almost all of the 10 traits examined...So 'the clothes make the man', as the saying goes. You dress to be like the person you want to be and observers use this information to form accurate judgments for a variety of traits.

What it also means is that you can change how people view your personality and then maybe your personality itself... 'As we predicted, physical appearance serves as a channel through which personality is manifested,' say the authors... '...we identified domains of accuracy that have been overlooked, leading to the conclusion that physical appearance may play a more important role in personality judgment than previously thought.'

"Like it or not, you are being judged by how you look, how you dress, and how you carry yourself - and, if you're lucky, how you do your job...According to a study in the Journal of Labor Research, workers who exercise regularly earn nine percent more on average than employees who don't work out...A Yale University study from Daniel Hamermesh finds employers pay a beauty premium to attractive employees..."

**"Guys on Immodesty, Lust, and
the Violence of Women's
Bodies...Lisa Wade, PhD on July
27, 2010...Crossposted at Jezebel:**

"...Administered by a Christian website, the survey questions were submitted by 'Christian girls' who wanted to know what 'Christian guys' think is modest. 1,600 guys then answered the survey...Why would girls care what guys, as opposed to God, think? Because Christian guys, their future husbands, are judging them on their modesty. Ninety-five percent of them say that modesty is an important quality in their future wife...So, how do these 'guys' define immodesty? The most common theme was dressing to draw attention to the body instead of the heart or spirit. 'Something that is immodest is something that is designed to arouse lust within me' (male, age 24). 'Something that is immodest is something that is unnaturally revealing' (male, age 20).

'Something immodest draws attention to a girl's body' (male, age 28). 'Something attractive draws you toward them. It makes you respect the person. Something immodest is usually unattractive. It makes you think less of that person, thinking of them as an object...' (male, age 16). 'My responsibility is to not treat women as objects for my satisfaction, even if they dress and act like it. It devalues them, and makes me a user of people...' (male, age 26)...So what rules for girls did guys identify?

Well, first, guys largely agreed that revealing clothes were immodest...Halter tops and mini skirts, I suppose, are obvious candidates for immodesty. There were lots more subtle rules, too, though with less agreement...Forty-seven think that t-shirts with messages across the front improperly draw attention to [that area]...Attaining modesty was also about how you use your body and the way you act...'An immodest lady is loud, proud, and dresses in a way that communicates such an attitude' (male, age 24)...'Something becomes immodest when the person wearing it has an attitude of carelessness' (male, age 17)...These Christian guys, however, did claim responsibility for their own thoughts, feelings, and actions.

When asked about their role in avoiding lust, many were adamant that it was their own responsibility. Many felt that innocent, shameless, platonic interaction between men and women was a team effort: 'Sisters in Christ, you really have no concept of the struggles that guys face on a daily basis. Please, please, please take a higher standard in the ways you dress. True, we men are responsible for our thoughts and actions before the Lord, but it is such a blessing when we know that we can spend time with our sisters in Christ, enjoying their fellowship without having to constantly be on guard against ungodly thoughts brought about by the inappropriate ways they sometimes dress....That goal is to bring glory to the Savior through an obedient, unified body of believers – please don't hurt that unity by dressing in ways that may tempt your brothers in Christ to stumble' (male, age 24)..."
