Anointing: The Error of Pop Christianity

These things have I written unto you concerning them that seduce you.

But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you... (1 John 2:26-27)

Seduce: 4105 planao

To cause one to roam from safety, truth or virtue

...but ye have an unction from the Holy One... (1 John 2:20)

...and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him. (1 John 2:27)

Seduce: 4105 planao

To cause one to roam from safety, truth or virtue

Symptoms

- 1. Mood altering music
- 2. Ordering the Holy Spirit around
- 3. Intense manipulation and crowd control
- 4. Makes unauthorized exagerated promises on behalf of God
- 5. Dramatics and sensationalism
- 6. Supposing 'Gain is godliness'
- 7. Extracting "seed monies"
- 8. Excusing misconduct and antics as "anointing"
- 9. Breeds discontent with "mere christianity"
- 10. Builds following of a personality vs Jesus
- 11. Anointing becomes a point of self boasting
- 12. Anointing is transferred from person to person

What The Bible Says About The Anointing

- 1. The anointing is given to every true believer
- 2. You receive the anointing from Christ
- 3. The anointing is resident in you
- 4. The anointing teaches you all things in respect to counter ing those that try to seduce you
- 5. The anointing is truth without lies
- 6. The anointing teaches us to abide in Christ
- 7. Christ is the "Anointed One"
- 8. Anointing is transferred from Christ to us first hand
- 9. Christ's same anointing is what is given to us



Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood, and hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen. (Revelations 1:5-6)

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

And he closed the book, and he gave it again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on him. (Luke 4:16-21)

And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord.

Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you.

And their eyes were opened; (Matthew 9:26-30)

And I will bring distress upon men, that they shall walk like blind men, because they have sinned against the LORD: (Zephaniah 1:17)

And Jesus said, For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind.

And some of the Pharisees which were with him heard these words, and said unto him, Are we blind also?

Jesus said unto them, If ye were blind, ye should have no sin: but now ye say, We see; therefore your sin remaineth. (John 9:39-41)

Therefore they could not believe, because that Esaias said again,

He hath blinded their eyes, and hardened their heart; that they should not see with their eyes, nor understand with their heart, and be converted, and I should heal them. (John 12:39)

Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart:

Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. (Ephesians 4:18-19)

- 3. To preach deliverance to captives
- 4. To preach recovering of sight to blind
- 5. To set at liberty them that are bruised
- 6. To preach the acceptable year of the Lord

And he spake a parable unto them, Can the blind lead the blind? shall they not both fall into the ditch? (Luke 6:39)

Then came his disciples, and said unto him, Knowest thou that the Pharisees were offended, after they heard this saying?

But he answered and said, Every plant, which my heavenly Father hath not planted, shall be rooted up.

Let them alone: they be blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch. (Matthew 15:12-14)

Woe unto you, ye blind guides, which say, Whosoever shall swear by the temple, it is nothing; but whosoever shall swear by the gold of the temple, he is a debtor!

Ye fools and blind: (Matthew 15:16-17)

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

Ye blind guides, which strain at a gnat, and swallow a camel.

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye make clean the outside of the cup and of the platter, but within they are full of extortion and excess.

Thou blind Pharisee, cleanse first that which is within the cup and platter, that the outside of them may be clean also. (Matthew 15:23-26)

His watchmen are blind: they are all ignorant, they are all dumb dogs, they cannot bark; sleeping, lying down, loving to slumber. (Isaiah 56:10)

But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which vail is done away in Christ.

But even unto this day, when Moses is read, the vail is upon their heart. (2 Corinthians 3:14-15)

But he that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes. (1 John 2:11)
