

"Giving" The Producers II Corinthians 9:6-15

Biblical giving requires a:

I. Strategy – "not grudgingly or of necessity" (vs. 6-7)

Our strategy includes:

- A. Principle "he which sows bountifully shall reap bountifully"
- B. Priorities "every man as he purposes in his heart"
- C. Predisposition "God loves a cheerful giver"

II. Source - "to prove" (vs. 8-10)

Our source comes from:

- **A.** Who "God is able to make all grace abound toward you"
- **B.** What "you, having all sufficiency in all things, may abound"
- III. Success "subjection unto the gospel of Christ" (vs. 11-15)

Our success is when there is:

- A. Enrichment "enriched in every thing to all bountifulness"
- **B.** Edification "this service...supplies the want of the saints"
- C. Exaltation "They glorify God for your professed subjection"
