

Revelation 15:1-8

Seven Angels with Seven Plagues

Right now, in our day today, Israel is the focus of world attention. Revelation says Israel will be the focus of world attention in the end days. We live in a fascinating time.

As far as the prophetic word goes, we are a little bit past the middle of the tribulation.

Vs1: this sign is great and marvelous, not just great. It's the ultimate sign he's seen so far. They are the 7 angels with the 7 last plagues, filled with the wrath of God. Plague in Greek means a disastrous event, either biological or ecological, but whatever it is, it has an enormous impact on humanity. Remember anytime 7 is used in scripture, it means complete, God's finale. God is saying 'enough is enough'. God will recluse himself, and not have anything to do with anybody until this is over. God has feelings. He'll need to regroup Himself.

Vs2: sea of glass mingled with fire: sea of glass – not literally, but it looks like it. This one is mingled with fire, and fire represents judgment. Those who refused Satan during the tribulation and were killed are standing on this sea of glass. Harps of God...harps stimulate the human immune system.

Vs 3: They sing the song of Moses. What is this? Exodus 15, after the Israelites cross the Red Sea and the sea closes up; they sing a song of deliverance from their enemies. Go to Deuteronomy 32 and read the entire chapter. This is a complete kaleidoscope prophetic chapter of the entirety of the nation of Israel from God's perspective. Jerusalem will be the capitol of this world. In Zachariah, this book says 2/3 of all Jewish people will die.

And they sing the song of the Lamb, so there are 2 songs here.

Vs4: not many people anywhere in this world fear the true God. It's like raising children-you love them, and if you care, you chastise them for bad behavior or they'll grow up rotten. The whole world will come to Jesus Christ and worship him after each judgment it made manifest... is in effect, is happening on the earth and every human being will know it, without question.

Vs5: there is a temple and tabernacle in heaven and it's a testimony to God. Now it's opened. God showed it to Moses, and God told him to make it, so Moses used it as a blueprint.

Vs6: 7 angels came out with pure white robes (purity of God), girdled in gold.

Vs7: one of the four beasts (living creatures) gave the 7 angels 7 vials (bowls) full of the wrath of God.

Vs8: each bowl contains a specific judgment upon man and the earth. No man could enter the temple until the 7 plagues have been fulfilled.
