- ²² And immediately He compelled the disciples to get into the boat and to precede Him unto the other side, while He released the crowds.
- ²³ And after He released the crowds, He went up into the mountain privately, to pray. And after evening fell,¹ He was there, alone.
- ²⁴ Now the boat already was many stadia² distant from land though tormented by the waves, for the wind was contrary.³
- ²⁵ And on the fourth watch of the night,⁴ He came up to them — walking across the sea!
- ²⁶ But the disciples, seeing Him upon the sea, walking, were shaken,⁵ saying, "It is a ghost!⁶" And they cried out from fear.
- ²⁷ And immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, "Take heart, it is I!⁷ Stop being afraid!"
- ²⁸ And in answer, Peter said, "Lord, if it is You, order me to (*Matthew 14:22-36*)

come up to You across the waters."

- ²⁹ And He said, "Come!" And, getting down from the boat, Peter began to walk across the waters, and he came up to Jesus.
- ³⁰ But, seeing *that* the wind *was* strong, he became afraid; and, beginning to sink, he cried out, saying, "Lord, save me!"
- ³¹ And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and⁸ took hold of him; and He says to him, "Little-faith, why⁹ did you doubt?"
- ³² And when they got up into the boat, the wind abated.
- ³³ And those in the boat worshipped Him, saying, "Truly, You are the Son of God!"
- ³⁴ And crossing over, they came to the land, at Gennesaret.
- ³⁵ And when the men of that place recognized Him, they sent word into all that vicinity, and they brought to Him all those doing¹⁰ badly,
- ³⁶ and they kept urging him that they might only touch the tassel of His coat; and as many as touched were quite saved.¹¹
