QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

- 1. Who directs Philip to travel on the road to Gaza? Who does Philip meet on the road? What does Luke want us to know about this man, and why?
- 2. How does Christ's leading of Philip differ from His leading of us today? How is it the same?
- 3. Philip engages the eunuch with a question. What are some good questions we might ask people today in order to strike up a gospel conversation?
- 4. Why is it significant that the eunuch was reading Isaiah 53? What is this chapter about? And how do the subsequent chapters (especially 56:1-8) find fulfillment here?
- 5. Why is this man filled with joy after his baptism? How does the gospel of Christ bring true, lasting joy and satisfaction in a way like nothing else can?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

- 1. Practically speaking, do I have the tendency to live as a deist or atheist, as if the people and situations I face are random? How would growing to recognize Christ's providential rule over my days help me to be more faithful as His witness?
- 2. Is the Bible a dead-letter to me? Has the Spirit of Christ opened my eyes to its truth and am I continuing to seek after Him for this illumination?
- 3. Has the truth of the gospel grown dull to me, or is it the continual fuel of my joy?
