Captured in the repeated phrases: hebel, chasing the wind, under the sun, labor, profit, gift, good, joy/enjoy, and death

- A. Hebel's pervasiveness
 - 1. Hebel is a constancy of life
 - 2. Hebel is God's judgment
 - 3. God is sovereign over *hebel*
 - 4. Often coupled with "chasing the wind"
- B. Under the sun
- C. Labor
- D. ProfitMan's transience challenges his sense of value of work and life.
- E. Good, gift, reward, joy (enjoy, rejoice)
- F. God in Ecclesiastes

So enjoy life, fear God, keep His commandments, recognize the hebel, know your limitations and you will experience the joy of vaporous life under the sun.
