I. What Does a Holy Spirit Filled Person Look Like? Acts 6:3

Therefore, brothers, pick out from among you seven men of good repute, **full of the Spirit** and of wisdom...

II. The Lampstand: Understanding the Picture(s)

- A. Almond Blossoms (Tree of Life; God's Watchful Presence)
- B. Seven Lamps: Continuous Bright Light
 - 1. Truth...Way
 - 2. Merciful, Fiery, Life-giving Prescience
 - 3. All these images are fulfilled in Jesus

John 8:12, 31–32

¹² Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "**I am the light** of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will *have the <u>light</u> of <u>life</u>." ...*

³¹ So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed in him, "If you *abide in my word*, you are truly my disciples, ³² and you will *know the truth*, and **the truth will set you free**."

III. The Light, Truth, and Life of the Holy Spirit

A. God's Fiery-Presence of the *Holy Spirit* Isaiah 63:10–12

¹⁰ But [Israel] rebelled and grieved <u>his</u> [God's] **Holy Spirit**; therefore <u>he</u> turned to be their enemy, and <u>himself</u> fought against them. ¹¹ Then <u>he</u> remembered the days of old, of Moses and <u>his</u> people. Where is <u>he</u> who brought them up out of the sea with the shepherds of <u>his</u> flock? Where is <u>he</u> who *put in the midst of them <u>his</u> Holy Spirit, ¹² who caused <u>his</u> glorious arm to go at the right hand of Moses, <u>who</u>* *divided the waters* before them to make for <u>himself</u> an everlasting name...

John 16:7, 13–15

⁷ Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the **Helper** will not come to you. But if I go, *I will send him to you*....

¹³ When the **Spirit of truth** comes, he will *guide you into all the truth*, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. ¹⁴ He will glorify me, for he will take what is mine and declare it to you. ¹⁵ All that the Father has is mine; therefore I said that he will take what is mine and declare it to you.

Acts 2:2-4

² And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. ³ And divided *tongues as of fire* appeared to them and rested on each one of them. ⁴ And they were all **filled with the** <u>Holy Spirit</u> and *began to speak in other tongues* as the Spirit gave them utterance.

B. We are God's Lampstand(s)

Key Idea

By the power of God in us, we reflect the bright light & life that Jesus provides to illuminate this dark world.

a. The seven Spirits of God

Revelation 1:4

⁴ John **to the** *seven* **churches** that are in Asia: Grace to you and peace from him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the <u>seven spirits</u> who are before his throne...

Revelation 4:5

⁵ From the throne came flashes of lightning, and rumblings and peals of thunder, and before the throne were burning <u>seven torches</u> of fire, *which are the* <u>seven spirits</u> of God...

Revelation 5:6

⁶ And between the throne and the four living creatures and among the elders I saw a Lamb standing, as though it had been slain, with seven horns and with <u>seven eyes</u>, *which are the <u>seven spirits</u> of God* sent out into all the earth.

b. The seven lampstands

Revelation 1:12–13a, 20b

¹² Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking to me, and on turning I saw *seven* golden lampstands, ¹³ and in the midst of the lampstands one like a son

<u>of man</u>...

... the seven lampstands are the seven churches.

C. What Does a Light-Filled/Holy Spirit Filled Person Look Like?

Matthew 5:14–16

¹⁴ "*You* are the <u>light</u> of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden.¹⁵ Nor do people *light a lamp* and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house.¹⁶ In the same way, *let your light shine before others*, so that they may see your good works and <u>give glory to your Father</u> who is in heaven.

- John the Baptist (Luke 1:15)
- John's Mother Elizabeth (Luke 1:41–45)
- John's father Zechariah (Luke 1:67)
- Pentecost (Acts 2:4; sermon outline p. 2)
- Peter (Acts 4:8 Rulers in Jerusalem/healing crippled man)
- Saul/Paul (Acts 9:17; Acts 13:9–10ff)

Acts 4:31 (The Church – Persecution)

And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all *filled with the Holy Spirit* and *continued to speak the word of God with boldness*. (Cf. Matt. 12:34; Lk. 6:45)

Ephesians 5:15–20 (Cf. Philippians 2:14–16)

¹⁵ Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, ¹⁶ making the best use of the time, because the days are evil. ¹⁷ Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is. ¹⁸ And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but *be filled with the Spirit*, ¹⁹ *addressing one another* in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord <u>with your heart</u>, ²⁰ giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ...

IV. Do You Know God?

Luke 11:13 (Cf. Acts 8:18–22)

If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the **Holy Spirit** to *those who ask him!*"
