- You Can Trust In Jesus!
 - And That Is Why In 6:17a The Disciples "Entered into a ship, and went over the sea toward Capernaum!"
 - They Believed & Trusted In Jesus:
 - That He Knew Best!
- But It Didn't Take Long:
 - And Their Faith Was Tested Again!
 - Because Also In 6:17:
 - We Find The Disciples Again In:
- 2. A Very Dark Place!
 - 6:17b "And it was now dark, and Jesus was not come to them!"
 - When It Is Dark:
 - It Makes Things Much Harder!
 - And This Was True:
 - Even For The Experienced Fisherman On That Ship!
 - It Would Have Been:

- Harder To See!
 - To See The Shores:
 - Where They Left And:
 - Where They Were Going!
 - And It Would Have Been Much:
- Harder To Steer!
 - No Doubt The Sailors On That Ship:
 - Would Have Done This Before!
 - But They Were Already:
 - Tired & Weary:
 - From That Long Day!
 - And Now They Had:
 - A Long Night To Look Forward To:
 - Without Jesus:
 - In Their Midst!
- Indeed They Were In:
 - A Very Dark Place!
 - But When We Look At The Other Gospel Accounts:
 - We Know Something:
 - That They Did Not Know!
 - Because In Mark 6:47-48:
 - We Are Told That "And when even was come, the ship was in the midst of the sea, and he alone on the land. / And he *saw* them!"
 - Now The Sea Of Galilee:
 - At Its Widest Point:
 - Is About 8 Miles Broad!
 - So To Be "In The Midst Of The Sea" Would Be About:
 - 4 Miles Away From The Shore!

- But In Spite Of The Distance!
 - And In Spite Of The Darkness!
 - Who Saw Them?
- Jesus Saw Them!
 - And That Is Why:
 - He Was The Solution:
 - For Their Fears!
 - Because Nothing Can Get In The Way:
 - Of The Eyes Of Jesus:
 - When He Sets His Sights:
 - On His People!
- Sometimes In Your Own Life:
 - This World Can Feel Like:
 - A Very Dark Place!
 - Just Like The Night:
