

Sermon: Called, Justified, Glorified  
Scripture: Romans 8:13-30 (text vs. 30)

Introduction: Ephesians 2:8; II Timothy 1:9

- I. Called
  - A. Used in Scripture as to a group of people (vs. 28)
  - B. Used in Scripture as an action by God for His people (I Cor. 1:9; II Thess. 2:13,14; I Peter 1:15; 2:9; 5:10).
  - C. God's calling of His people is a special calling, not a general calling (John 7:37; 6:44; Eph. 2:1; I Cor. 2:14; John 3:19).
  - D. Irresistible grace – example Abraham, Paul
  
- II. Justified
  - A. Stated, explained (Romans 3:21-26): a legal term, “not guilty”
  - B. Because of Christ (Phil. 3:7-9; II Cor. 5:21)
  - C. Through faith (Phil. 3:9; Eph. 2:8,9)
  
- III. Glorified (Rom. 8:18,21; Col. 3:3,4; John 3:16, 5:24; 10:27-30)
  
- IV. Application
  - A. Let us make our calling and election sure (II Peter 4:10).
  - B. Let us be filled with much joy and worship for our justification.
  - C. Let us comfort our hearts in the certainty of our glorification.
