How to Live a Truly Meaningful Life with God at the Center

1. Live with your death in view (7:1-4).

Jonathan Edwards's Resolutions

- 7. Resolved, never to do anything, which I should be afraid to do, if it were the last hour of my life.
- 9. Resolved, to think much on all occasions of my own dying, and of the common circumstances which attend death.
- 17. Resolved, that I will live so as I shall wish I had done when I come to die.
- 52. I frequently hear persons in old age say how they would live, if they were to live their lives over again: resolved, that I will live just so as I can think I shall wish I had done, supposing I live to old age.

How to Live a Truly Meaningful Life with God at the Center

- 1. Live with your death in view (7:1-4).
- 2. Value wisdom, but don't expect too much from it (7:5-12).
- 3. Accept adversity from God just like you receive prosperity from him (7:13-14).
- 4. Avoid the pitfalls of both legalism and license (7:15-18).
- 5. Lower your expectations of other people; they're sinners just like you (7:19-29).
