your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.


Give us this day our daily bread,

#138 The Heavens Declare Your Glory, Lord

TO THE CHOIRMASTER. A PSALM OF DAVID.

- ¹ The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork.
- ² Day to day pours out speech, and night to night reveals knowledge.
- ³ There is no speech, nor are there words, whose voice is not heard.
- ⁴ Their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world.

In them he has set a tent for the sun,

- which comes out like a bridegroom leaving his chamber, and, like a strong man, runs its course with joy.
- ⁶ Its rising is from the end of the heavens, and its circuit to the end of them, and there is nothing hidden from its heat.
- ⁷The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul;
- the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple;
- ⁸ the precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart;
- the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes;
