### ...pray...

I am sad to say I don't believe that everyone in this room is in Christ.

Yet I'm *convinced* that *no one* in this room who *turns to Christ* will be *turned away* disappointed.

Your relationship to God is *life's most important issue*...the *ultimate question*.

Don't you even *think* about dying before I tell you these *six* truths (2 more this morning)!

Last week:

- 1. God owns you.
- 2. You disowned God.

This morning:

- 3. God judges sinners.
- 4. Jesus died for sinners.

Next Sunday, Lord willing...

- 5. Jesus lives again (now).
- 6. You must choose.

First, a *brief review* of these first two truths:

Here is the *first fact* that everyone needs to hear about God: *God made you*. He made you *personally*. He made you in His *own image*. Because He *made* you, He *owns* you. Because He *owns* you, you are *accountable* to Him.

**Next truth**: You disowned God. God is your Creator-King, and you are a willful rebel. You break His laws. You make your own rules. You put Him off. You pretend He doesn't care or doesn't even exist. You're a rebel!

What will the righteous "King of Creation" do with a rebel...?

# Bad news first: God judges sinners.

- 1. The *moment* you were born, you were handed a *one-way ticket* to the *grave*! I don't know what your **ETA** is, but I know you're *going*.
  - a. Turn w/ me to **Heb 9:27.** "appointed" The **NT**'s vocab & grammar here is simple & clear your death is an ever-present reality. God has **penned** in (not penciled in) your death in your appointment calendar.
  - b. **OBTW** -You only die *once*. *Reincarnation* is a baseless myth (deceptive *lie*). There are *no return tickets* from death.
  - c. But that's not the *whole story* (some *wish* it were). Something happens *after* you depart this life. → *Judgment*. Read carefully: God *judges* every *woman* & *man*.
  - d. **OBTW** # 2 Death is not *annihilation*. You will *consciously* meet God in judgment when you depart this world.
  - e. Do you remember what the Bible says about our *moral* condition before our *Maker*?
    - i. God is King & Judge. You are rebel & transgressor. All have sinned & fall short of the glory of God.
    - ii. Your King is going to catch up w/you & judge you!

- 2. This simply *isn't* debatable! Your Bible portrays God as *mankind's Judge* from **OT** to **NT**. Listen to this review of biblical claims that God is humanity's judge:
  - a. **Gen3:1-19** Even though they only have *one rule* to keep, *Adam & Eve* break it. The entire *human family* is marred. The *first Garden* becomes the *first Courtroom* as *God* judges the *Tempter & Eve & Adam*. All mankind…all creation, *suffers*.
  - b. Gen 18:25 Abraham knew it: "Will not the Judge of all the earth deal justly?"
  - c. **Psa 1:5** The psalmists said it: Therefore the wicked will not stand in the **judgment**...
  - d. **Psalm 50:6** And the heavens declare His righteousness, for **God Himself is judge**. Selah.
  - e. Matt 10:28 Jesus taught it: "Do not fear those who kill the body but are unable to kill the soul; but rather [fear Him who is able to destroy both soul & body in hell."] 2X
  - f. **Heb 13:4** The writer of Heb warned about it: ...fornicators & adulterers **God will judge**.
  - g. **Jas 4:12** The Apostle *James* recognized it: *There is only one Lawgiver & Judge*, the One who is able to save & destroy.
  - h. **Rev 20:11** The Apostle *John* saw it coming at the close of the Millennial Kingdom and on the threshold of the New Heavens & earth: ...and the dead were **judged**...according to their deeds (2X)

- 3. It is *undeniable & unavoidable*. *God judges sinners*! I'll bet you've got some *questions* about that. I've got **4** you should be *asking*:
  - a. *First*, I'm going to *re-frame* the truth we've already stressed. It's just too *crucial* to ignore (**Q1**): *Will God judge your sins?* 
    - i. Yes, He will.
    - ii. I'll simply *restate* the vs. we considered a moment ago: And inasmuch as it is appointed for men to die once & after [death] comes judgment. (Heb 9:27)
  - b. **Q2:** *Does God have the right?* 
    - i. Isaiah wrote, "Woe to the one who quarrels w/his Maker an earthenware vessel among the vessels of the earth! Will the clay say to the potter, "What are you doing?" or the thing you are making say, "He has no hands?'
    - ii. Friend, He *made* you, He *owns* you, ...yes, God has the *right* to *judge* you.
  - c. But... Is God's standard too high (Q3)? It is high! Mt 5:48 (Jesus) "Therefore you are to be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect."
    - i. Can't God *ease off* on that...?
    - ii. *No*, God judges you by *Himself holy perfection*! He *must*.
    - iii. What happens to *perfect*, the moment perfect accepts a *moral flaw*, or *compromise*? Just like a *white carpet* shows the *smallest black stain*, if God lowers the *standard* for us, **He** won't be *perfect*. He'll be an *unjust judge*. An *unholy* God.

- d. **Q:3** What **is** God's just sentence on unrepentant sinners? **Hell.** 
  - i. Read **Mt 10:28** And do not be afraid of those who *kill the body* but are unable to *kill the soul*; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both *soul* and *body* in hell.
  - ii. Hell is *eternal & conscious & painful* existence *separated* from everything that is *gracious* about God.
  - iii. You might say "Who cares I'm already not living w/ God!"
  - iv. *Careful* that isn't really true! If you are *in this room*, even though *not* in *Christ*, you still enjoy *unimaginable* (often *unappreciated*) *blessings* from God, *every moment*. But you *won't* have them in *hell not* one little blessing *not ever* again...  $\odot$
- 4. God made you. You rebelled against Him. God's punishment for your rebellion is death & judgment.
  - a. **Hey** "I thought this Gospel stuff was **good news**!" Where's the good news in judgment? Where's the love…!?! I came to church this morning to get some air pumped in my tires!
  - b. That's the *dilemma* of the Gospel, young friends! If *this* is all you know (these *first* **3** truths God is your *King*, you are a *rebel*, your King will *judge* you), it's *not* good news yet. But *good news* is coming *mercy* is coming, *love* is coming!

## And so the Gospel's *fourth* truth **is** *good news!*: **Jesus** *died* **for sinners!**

- 1. Listen carefully while I introduce the *more good news*: [Every sin has to be *paid for*. But **not** necessarily by the *sinner himself*!] **2X**
- 2. Turn w/ me in your NT to 2 Cor 5:21 (p.287). God made Christ who
  - a. There are only **3** characters in this *life-changing drama* we just read together v.21: *God & His Son & sinners*.
  - b. God's Son, Jesus, lived a perfectly *righteous life*. But all of us were born in our *sins*.
  - c. Then God caused His Son to *become* (take on) someone else's *sin*! And to be *completely punished* for it.
  - d. But that's *not all*! If Jesus is *sinless*, He is *righteous*. God, somehow, made it possible for repentant sinners to be credited with the *righteousness* of His Son; to have it *indelibly inscribed* in the repenter's *moral ledger*.
  - e. Don't you see it this is incredibly great news (repeat 5:21)!?!
  - **f.** I want to *start* from here, and explore **3 more** *huge ideas* w/ you: *atonement* & *substitution* & *Jesus Christ*.

- 3. First huge idea: atonement defined.
  - **a.** *Atonement*, or *to atone*, means to *pay the price* of an offense. To *satisfy* God's justice. So, what *pays* for sin?
    - t. Turn w/ me to **Heb 9:22.** Do you see it? Blood (death) pays for sin. The currency of atonement is blood.
    - 11. Atonement is related to the idea of redemption buying something for a price. In the NT redemption is slavemarket language. Christ is paying the price (currency is still blood) to redeem you out of the slave market of sin.
    - iii. Atonement means to pay the price of sin. We live in a culture that prizes paying its own way but young friend, you don't want to stand before the Judge and pay this ticket yourself... Jesus offers to pay it for you!
- 4. Second big idea (join me in Mark 10:45): substitution defined.
  - a. Jesus has just declared His mission, and his mission is *substitution*. We know what that is: *one* in place of *others*!
  - b. It happens all the time in *sports*. Players are *sub'd in* off the *bench* or out of the *bull-pen*.
  - c. In the American *War Between the States*, *conscripted* (drafted) men were allowed to find (pay) someone else to *take their place*. Perhaps that man would *march off* to battle & *die* in your place.
  - d. In the **OT**, God specified that offerings of *bulls & rams & goats* would symbolically *receive* the sins of the *worshiper*, and be *sacrificed* in the place of *guilty men & women*. It was meant to be a *preview* of *atonement* by *substitution*.
  - e. One in the place of another. But can anyone be found to pay for your sins...?

- 5. *Third* eternally enormous idea: *Jesus Christ* identified. Who *is* Jesus, and why is He *good news?* 
  - a. Jesus is *God*. The **NT** Gospel of John begins the story of Jesus like this: Before the beginning began, the Word existed, and the Word was w/God, and the Word was God...and the Word became flesh and pitched His tent in our midst.
    - i. That's Jesus Christ! Jesus is God in flesh, in our camp!
    - ii. And because He's God, He's *perfect* Jesus has *no* sin of His own to pay for.
  - b. Yet Jesus is also *man*. Being a man causes Him to be *sympathetic* to your needs & failings. Being a man also means He's qualified to *represent* you (to *substitute* for you). Before someone can *sub* for you on the *soccer field*, they've got to be on *your* team. *Jesus is on your team*, friend! Being a man means that Jesus *died*. He was *crucified* (*executed* on a cross) and on that cross died as a *sinless substitute* for sinners like us.

#### c. Jesus is the *Savior*!

- i. **John the** *Baptist* pointed to Jesus and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world."
- ii. **John the** *Apostle* wrote, *For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosever believes in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life.*
- iii. **Jesus said**, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but through Me."
- iv. Again, here is the *short version*: Jesus died on the *cross* to *pay (atone)* for the *sins* of others, *in their place*. Could that be *you*...!?!
- d. Jesus is *Lord*. This is *the* fav title for Jesus in **NT!** It's related to the idea of *King* & of *God*.
  - i. You don't *bargain* w/ Jesus & you can't *come* to Jesus as your *substitute* & *Savior* w/o coming to Him as your *Lord*.
  - ii. The dangerous idea that Jesus will *save* you but allow you to live any *sinful* or *careless* way you *choose*, simply doesn't exist in your **NT**. He came to *save* you & to *sanctify* you & to *rule* you.

- 6. Those 3 huge ideas you do the math! Atonement + Substitution + Jesus (God-man, mankind's Savior & Lord).
  - a. Add 'em up did you get the right answer?
    - i. Jesus Christ, *dying* on the cross, *bearing* your sins, being *punished* in your place, *paying* your penalty, *adds up to* the *only way* your sins can be *paid* for & God's *judgment* on you *satisfied*,...
    - ii. & therefore the *only way* you can gain *eternal life*, and the *only way* that *love* & *joy* & *purpose* & *peace* & *hope* can be yours! Now, & *forever*.
- 7. I've explained at length that God is a *holy Judge*, who can't leave sin *unpunished*. The cross is **a** place where sins are *punished*. The cross tells us that God is uncompromisingly *holy* & *just*.
  - a. What *else* does the *Cross of Jesus* tell you about God...?
  - **b.** God is *love*. He is, at the same time, both *holy* and *loving*.
    - i. For God so loved the world that He gave His only...
    - ii. But God demonstrated His own love towards us...
    - iii. God made Christ, who knew no sin, to be sin on our...
    - iv. He loved us & sent His Son to be the propitiation for our

God is *Creator-Judge*. You are a *rebel*. The King *judges* rebels. But Jesus *died* in the place of *rebels*.

What truths make up these biblical promises we call the "Gospel"?

God owns you.

You disowned God.

God *judges* sinners. (These first 3 truths sound a lot like <u>bad\_news!</u>) But Jesus *died* for sinners.

Jesus lives again. (Next Lord's Day)

Leaving you w/ a choice.

...pause...

Have you been *thinking* about this – this past *week* (maybe *longer*...)?

God has the *answer* for your greatest need. He lovingly *sent* His Son Jesus to *die*, to *bear the punishment* deserved by sinners like you & me.

God *raised* Jesus from the dead & He's *alive* **today** to offer you *forgiveness* & *eternal life*.

**Your part** is to *believe* that Jesus died for you, to *turn* to Him & to *trust/follow* Him as your *Savior* & *Lord*. **God's part** is to *accept* you & give you a new *heart/life*. ... *forever*.

He'll do His part if you'll do yours!

So you *must choose*: *your* way or *His*. Please stop *putting Him off*. He is a *loving Savior* – please, *follow Christ*.
