 - i. a possible scenario vs 11a If they say,
 - ii. "Come with us,
 - Let us lie in wait to shed blood;
 - Let us lurk secretly for the innocent without cause;
 - Let us swallow them alive like Sheol,

And whole, like those who go down to the Pit;

- Cast in your lot among us,
- Let us all have one purse" -
- c. The Seduction vs 13
 - i. We shall find all kinds of precious possessions,
 - ii. We shall fill our houses with spoil;
- 2. The Admonition vs 15-18
 - a. Appeal based n relationship vs 15a
 - b. The Command
 - i. do not walk in the way with them, Ps 1:1
 - ii. Keep your foot from their path;
 - c. The Why
 - i. Their Character
 - For their feet run to evil, Isa 59:7; Ro 3:15
 - And they make haste to shed blood.
 - ii. Their Vanity
 - Surely, in vain the net is spread In the sight of any bird;
 - But they lie in wait for their own blood,
 - They lurk secretly for their own lives.
 - b. The Character Flaw vs 19
 - i. So are the ways of everyone who is greedy for gain; 1Ti 6:10
 - ii. It takes away the life of its owners.
- B. The Encouragement toward Wisdom vs 20-33
 - 1. The Invitation
 - a. Wisdom calls aloud outside; vs 20; Pr 8:1; 9:3; Joh 7:37
 - i. She raises her voice in the open squares.
 - ii. She cries out in the chief concourses,
 - iii. At the openings of the gates in the city She speaks her words:
 - b. Her Call vs 21-23

- i. The Audience and Question
 - to the simple "How long, love simplicity?
 - to the scorners "How long, will you delight in their scorning,
 - And to the fools "How long, will you hate knowledge.
- ii. The Command and Obedience's Blessings
 - Turn at my rebuke; (Repent)
 - Surely I will pour out my spirit on you;
 - I will make my words known to you.
- 2. The Rejection and its Consequences
 - a. Wisdom's Effort and their refusal vs 24-25; Isa 65:12; 66:4
 - i. Because I have called and you refused,
 - ii. I have stretched out my hand and no one regarded,
 - iii. Because you disdained all my counsel, And would have none of my rebuke,
 - b. Wisdom's reaction to their Rejection vs 26-27
 - i. I also will laugh at your calamity; Ps 2:4
 - ii. I will mock when your terror comes,
 - When your terror comes like a storm,
 - And your destruction comes like a whirlwind,
 - When distress and anguish come upon you.
 - c. Their Response When Terror Comes and Wisdom's Why vs 28-31
 - i. Their Response to Terror
 - "Then they will call on me, but I will not answer;
 - They will seek me diligently, but they will not find me.
 - God's Dealing w/ unrepentant Israel Isa 1:15; Jer 11:11; 14:12; Eze 8:18; Mic 3:4; Zec 7:13
 - ii. Wisdom's Reason for Denying Them
 - Because they hated knowledge Job 21:14
 - And did not choose the fear of the LORD,
 - They would have none of my counsel Ps 81:11
 - And despised my every rebuke.
 - iii. The Consequences vs 31
 - Therefore they shall eat the fruit of their own way, Pr 14:14;
 - And be filled to the full with their own fancies.
 - d. Consequences of Decisions vs 32-33
 - i. The Negative
 - For the turning away of the simple will slay them,
 - And the complacency of fools will destroy them;
 - ii. The Positive
 - But whoever listens to me will dwell safely, Ps 25:12-13
 - And will be secure, without fear of evil." Ps 112:7
