<u>Isa 60:20</u> Your sun shall no longer go down, Nor shall your moon withdraw itself; For the LORD will be your everlasting light, And the days of your mourning shall be ended. <u>21</u> Also your people shall all be righteous; They shall inherit the land forever, The branch of My planting, The work of My hands, <u>That I may be glorified</u>.

Review:

- Mankind <u>knew</u> God; His glory is evident. Rom 1:19-20
- Mankind <u>refused</u> to glorify God as God. Rom 1:21
- Mankind **replaced** God. Rom 1:21
- God gave man what he wanted Rom 1:24-28
- We **fell short** of God's glory. Rom 3:23

God has reclaimed us for his glory (Rom 5:1-5)

- 1) **Justified** by faith like Abraham. (4:19-25).
- 2) **Peace** The war is over between man and God if we believe.
- 3) **Access** The way to the Father is opened.
- 4) **Standing** We have standing in his presence.
- 5) **Glory** We rejoice in the hope of Glory!
 - a. **Suffering** is working for us. Rom 8:18
 - b. **Creation** is waiting on us. Rom 8:19-22
 - c. The hope of glory is **changing** us. Rom 8:24-30.
 - i. It is changing us into **loving people**. Rom 5:5
 - ii. It is changing us into more **glorious people** Rom 8:29 be glorified because God's love is unstoppable. My friend you are secure in Jesus.
