#### Hebrews 9

- Verses 1–5, The Old Covenant Tabernacle's Basic Structure The Most Holy Place was beyond the (merely) Holy Place.
- Verses 6–10, The Old Covenant Tabernacle's Basic Problem Its most sacred rituals couldn't actually cleanse sinners.
- Verses 11–14, The Superiority of Jesus's New Covenant Sacrifice Jesus entered God's presence, offering one sacrifice that can cleanse sinners.
- Verses 15–22, The Power of Jesus's New Covenant Sacrifice Jesus's death put into effect all the promises of the new covenant.
- Verses 23–28, The Finality of Jesus's New Covenant Sacrifice Jesus died once for sin; he won't die again. But he is coming again!

- 1. Jesus entered God's very presence.
- 2. Jesus offered himself as the sacrifice for sinners.
- 3. Jesus offered a "once for all time" sacrifice.
- 4. Jesus's sacrifice can actually cleanse and change us.
