## Psalm 67

1 To the chief Musician on Neginoth, A Psalm or Song. God be merciful unto us, and bless us; and cause his face to shine upon us; Selah. 2 That thy way may be known upon earth, thy saving health among all nations.

3 Let the people praise thee, O God; let all the people praise thee.

4 O let the nations be glad and sing for joy: for thou shalt judge the people righteously, and govern the nations upon earth. Selah.

5 Let the people praise thee, O God; let all the people praise thee.

6 Then shall the earth yield her increase; and God, even our own God, shall bless us. 7 God shall bless us; and all the ends of the earth shall fear him.

## Introduction:

- 1. "To the chief Musician" (see I Chr. 25:1-6).
- "Neginoth" meaning "smittings" to be played on stringed instruments. Mentioned 7X (Pss. 4, 6, 54, 55, 61, 76).
- 3. "A Psalm" instrumental music.
- 4. "A Song" vocal music.
- 5. "Bless" in v.1 and v.7 form an "inclusio" or envelop.

## **Observations**:

- 1. God saved us so that we can make His way known upon the earth. We are saved to serve.
- 2. The Millinnial Kingdom is partly the fullfilment of God's promise to Abraham (Gen. 12:1-3). "All nations" can benefit from this.
- 3. The purpose of salvation is to praise God.
- 4. God's justice will be the basis for the nations to be glad and sin for joy.
- 5. God's judgments are just and right.
- 6. What are we doing with God's blessings?

**Lesson**: We are blessed to be a blessing to others. We look forward to the time when God will rule and reign over all the nations.
