 - 1. Personal evangelism may require long patience with a slow and gradual growth in understanding and clarity on even the fundamentals of the Gospel.
 - 2. In such cases, we must watch for and encourage faithfulness and obedience to the truth that is known and understood this will be the unmistakable mark of the saving work of the Spirit.
 - The most severe opposition and condemnation of genuine faith in the truth of Gospel is may not come from unbelievers, but from those who claim to be Christians.
 - 4. Allow faith and sincerity to be tested in the one growing in a knowledge of the truth of the Gospel, and come alongside them with encouragement, solidarity, and the truth that will add faith to faith.
