## The Fifth Antithesis - Part 1

## Matthew 5:38-39a

Verse 38 Once again we will find that that the Jewish leaders cited the Old Testament teaching:

Exodus 21:22-25

Leviticus 24:19-20

Deuteronomy 19:16-21

Verse 39a Jesus counters the Pharisaic teaching with a focus on *individual responsibility* toward others, which indicates that He was responding to what the scribes and Pharisees had been telling *individuals* to do.

First, Jesus stressed not only that we should not take vengeance when wronged, but that we shouldn't even resist those who wrong us. But, in stressing that we should not take vengeance into our own hands, He was once again not teaching anything new, but was simply teaching what the Old Testament already taught.

Second, the Greek word here is masculine and should be taken not as a reference to evil as such, but to an evil man or person.
