

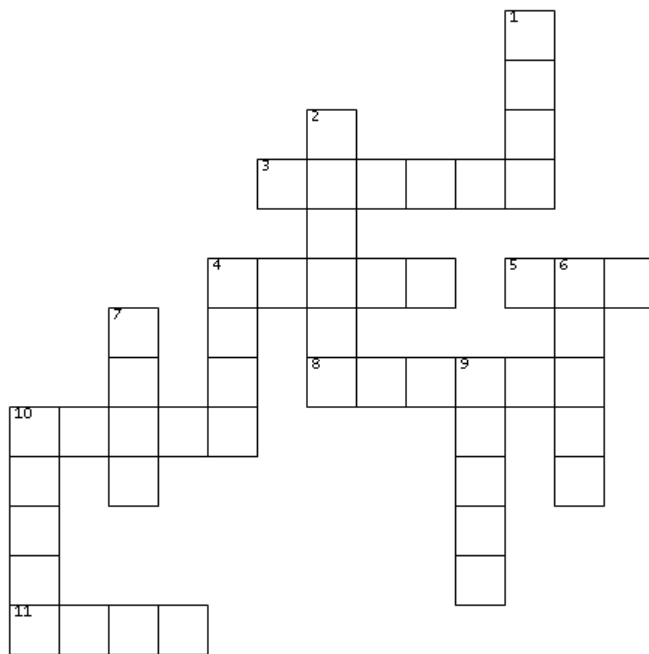

What does Revelation 20:1-6 reveal new about the Kingdom?

1. Satan will be bound in a bottomless pit for the duration of the Kingdom. (Of the three enemies we struggle with today – the world, the flesh, and the Devil – two of those will be neutralized during the Kingdom Age – the world and the Devil.) (Revelation 20:1-3)
2. The Kingdom Age will last 1000 years (a millennium). This is mentioned 6 times in 7 verses. (Revelation 20:1-7)
3. It appears saved people of all the previous dispensations (except the Church Age) will be resurrected to participate in the Kingdom Age. (Revelation 20:4-6)
