#### He's Got You Covered Exodus 26:1-14

#### Jesus is our:

I. Substitute – "fine twined linen...purple" (vs. 1-6)

Requiring Him to be:

- A. Human "being found in fashion as a man" Phil. 2:8
- B. Humble "humbled Himself, became obedient to death"
- C. Holy -"He who knew no sin" II Corinthians 5:21
- II. Scapegoat "of goats hair to be a covering" (vs. 7-13)

  Replacing condemnation with:
  - A. Cleansing "atonement...to cleanse you" Leviticus 16:30
  - B. Communion "be clean ... before the Lord"
- III. Security "a covering...of rams...badger skins" (v. 14)

  Relying on His:
  - A. Strength "kept by the power of God" I Peter 1:5
  - B. Sufficiency "I give unto them eternal life" John 10:28
  - C. Sealing "sealed with the Holy Spirit" Ephesians 1:13
