## I. DOCTRINE OF Lamb UNFOLDED

- 1. Genesis 4, Able and his lamb. [4:3-7a]
- 2. Genesis 22, a PROVIDED LAMB in the place of Isaac. [22:1-13]
- **3. Exodus 12**, the Passover lamb. [12:3-7; 12-13]
- 4. Leviticus, the PERFECT SIN offering Lamb. [22:21-22]
- 5. Isaiah 53, GOD lays the iniquity of us all on the suffering Lamb. [53:4-8]
- **6. John 1**, "Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the SIN of the world." [1:29]

- 6. John 1:29— THE LAMB OF GOD IS JESUS!
- 7. Acts 8:30-37— The Lamb is the Christ, the Promised Messiah.
- 8. | Peter 1:18-21— The resurrection of the Lamb.
- 9. Revelation 5:1-10; 5:6-8— The Lamb is now in Heaven, enthroned, victorious.
- 10. Revelation 21:1, 2; 22:3-5— The Lamb is King of kings!

## III. The Lamb Passages Unfold the Doctrine of Salvation

- 1. Genesis 4:3-7— the lamb was a propitiation for sin.
- 2. Genesis 22:1-13— substitution.
- 3. Exodus 12:1-13— Passover: Protection.
- 4. Leviticus 22:21-22— freeing from the guilt.
- 5. Isaiah 53:4-8— the Lamb suffered for us.
- 6. John 1:29— the Lamb removes our sin.
- 7. Acts 8:30-37— individual salvation.
- 8. | Peter 1:19-20— redemption through the Lamb.
- 9. Revelation 5:6-8— the Lamb ruling now.
- 10. Revelation 21 & 22— the eternal glory of the Lamb. The Lamb for all eternity; and all the saints reigning with the LAMB!

**REALITY:** ALL must face Him as the Lamb of **SALVATION**; OR as the Lamb of **WRATH**: **Rev. 6:15-17!**
