- I. Three reasons the resurrection of Jesus Christ is crucial
  - A. The resurrection is the central miracle of the Christian religion
  - B. The resurrection means grace (1 Corinthians 15:14-19)
  - C. The resurrection means justice for the world (Acts 17:30-31; Revelation 2:23)
- II. Four reasons people do not believe that the resurrection happened
  - A. Disbelief in miracles
  - B. Unreliability of the biblical accounts
  - C. Peace with death
  - D. Comfort with the status quo
- III. Five strange things about the resurrection of Jesus Christ
  - A. Resurrection doesn't fit with any Jewish messianic expectation (v. 6 cf. Luke 9:22,44-45)
  - B. None of the accounts are full of OT passages that it "fulfilled"
  - C. Enough variation in detail to back up its claim to multiple sources (see Matthew 28; Mark 16; Luke 24; John 20)
  - D. The first eyewitnesses were female
  - E. The unusual nature of Jesus' resurrection body (see Daniel 12:2-3 vs. Luke 24:31; John 20:19)
- IV. One thing you need to know: Jesus is risen
  - A. Why two angels? Because their news is better than the news of Jesus' birth.
  - B. A new creation has begun.
  - C. Justice is on the way.
  - D. Grace is poured out on us. Forgiveness of sins in his name. Faith and repentance and a restored relationship with God, a restored understanding of ourselves, restored communities and families and nations, the restoration even of the physical world in which we live.
  - E. Now is the year of Jubilee, the acceptable year of the Lord.
  - F. Our lives are for making disciples in his name, announcing his kingdom and teaching obedience to him, and manifesting that kingdom in justice and forgiveness and restoration and holiness.
