The Sacrificial Giver

2 Corinthians 8:1-5, 9

Introduction:

*How can people give sacrificially, when it would seemingly hurt to give?

- I. *People give sacrificially* when <u>God</u> does a work of <u>grace</u> in their hearts (v.1)
- **II.** *People give sacrificially* when the joy of the Lord <u>motivates</u> them to give (v.2a)
- III. *People give sacrificially* when they can <u>empathize</u> with the <u>need</u> they give towards (v.2b)
- IV. *People give sacrificially* when they are <u>not forced</u> to give, but give of their own <u>free</u> <u>will</u> (v.3)
- V. *People give sacrificially* when they are <u>burdened to share</u> in the <u>fellowship</u> of the saints (v.4)
- VI. *People give sacrificially* when they <u>first give themselves</u> as a sacrifice to the Lord (v.5)
- VII. *People give sacrificially* when they fully understand the <u>sacrifice Christ made</u> on our behalf (v.9)
