Sermon: "The Faithful Work to Survive." Ruth and Covenant Survival. Pt.5

I Text:

Old Covenant: Ruth 2:14-23

New Covenant: 1 Thessalonians 2:9-12; Acts 18:1-4; 20:33,34

II Doctrine:

Although Boaz was gracious to Ruth she still had to physically labor for her food. He was gracious to provide her with food as she gleaned, but she still had to glean!
