    - 1. 4th Commandment review (Ex. 20; Deut. 5)
    - 2. Ceremonial and moral law.
    - **3.** Expanding the commandment, just in case.
    - **4.** A question and a warning.
    - **5.** Can they be serious?

## II. Jesus crushes legalism with the Bible (25-26).

- **A.** "Have you never read?"
  - 1. More Bible, not less.
  - 2. Heartless religion doesn't hold up to the Bible.
  - 3. Libertine legalism.
- **B.** David and the holy bread (1 Sam. 21).
  - 1. On the run from Saul.
  - **2.** On the King's business.
  - **3.** Holy bread, for priests only (Lev. 24:5-9)
- C. Chew on this, Pharisee.

## III. Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath (27-28).

- **A.** Guilty of showing mercy on the Sabbath.
- **B.** What is the point of the Sabbath?
  - **1.** Authorial intent.
  - **2.** Sabbath, marriage, and creation order (Gen. 2; Ex. 20; Deut. 5; Is. 58; Mal. 2:13-16; Matt. 19:1-9; Mk. 2:22-28).
  - 3. The Sabbath is made for man.
  - **4.** God's law does not destroy man (Rom. 7:7, 13; 1 Cor. 15:56)
  - 5. Consider your ways (Hag. 1:1-11).
- **C.** Serving the Lord of the Sabbath is lawful on the Sabbath.
  - 1. Weekly reminder that all have a Master in heaven (Col. 3:22-4:1)
  - 2. Serve someone greater than the Temple (Matt. 12:5-7)
  - **3.** Your reasonable service (Ro. 12:1-2; Hag. 1:1-11)
- **D.** Our Lord and Master gives us rest.
  - 1. Physical rest.
  - 2. Spiritual rest.
  - 3. Give rest to others (Matt. 11:28).
