### THE BEST MEETING PLACE | HEBREWS 9:1-28

#### Jesus' sacrifice of himself provided

**Context:** After showing that our eternal High Priest Jesus has a better Covenant in chapter 8, the author of Hebrews now shows that he has a better Tabernacle (9:1-12) and Sacrifice (9:13-10:18), truths that impact us strongly today.

#### **Better Tabernacle (1-12)**

- Point: because Jesus has a better place of ministry, he is a superior person.
- The prescribed ceremonies that were external fell short of the internal access to God foreshadowed in the New Covenant.

## Judaism's one accomplishment (13): Christ's four accomplishments (14-28):

- 1. \_\_\_\_\_ our conscience (14-17)
- 2. \_\_\_\_\_ of a new covenant (18-22)
- 3. \_\_\_\_\_ heavenly sanctuary and puts Jesus in heaven as our high priest (23-24)
- 4. \_\_\_\_\_ our sins (25-28)
