Doing All to God's Glory

- I. **Our Chief End**
 - A. Doing all to the glory of God means we are called to worship God in all that we do for Who He is and what He has done.

B. What the text teaches is that this glory is for God **alone!**

- II. **Our Entire Life**
 - A. The text emphasizes that we must live for God's glory in every part and every moment of our lives: whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatever....

B. If we are to eat and drink to the glory of God, we must live the whole of our lives to glorify God.

- III. **Our Ability in Christ**
 - A. The bar is set high for us, which makes us to see that we don't have the ability in ourselves to live this way.

B. Yet, there is hope because this God Who we desire to serve is the God of our salvation.
