The Church at Pecan Creek Series: Hebrews

- 1. Genesis 3:15 contains a prophecy about the Savior which God will send Who will crush Satan. The Apostle Paul picks up on this passage in Galatians 4:1-7 as he talks about who Jesus is, and what His accomplishment means for believers. What benefit is the key benefit that Paul is focusing on in this passage?
- 2. Read Hebrews 2:9. This is a passage which uses the word "everyone" and is sometimes used by people to teach that Jesus died for every single person. However, the word "everyone" does not always carry the same meaning. It can either mean: everyone without distinction, or everyone without exception. Find out which one of these meanings is being used hear by studying the surrounding passages. Read Hebrews 2:8-16 for clues. For a good cross reference you may turn to Galatians 3:26-29 and John 6:37.
- 3. Part of the image of God that mankind maintained was the role of dominion. Even though sin had entered the world, this role was repeated even after Adam sinned. Look up the following verses to see how similar these commands are, and to whom the commands are given.
  - a. Genesis 1:28 \_\_\_\_\_
  - b. Genesis 9:1-2
  - c. Genesis 28:1-4 \_\_\_\_\_
  - d. Genesis 48:2-4 \_\_\_\_\_

4. In a very similar, yet different, way Christians are also commanded by God to multiply.

- a. Look at the following verses to determine what that multiplication looks like: Matthew 28:18-20, Acts 1:8, and Romans 10:13-15
- b. How can you become more obedient to the command to multiply?
- 5. Lastly, even Christians can struggle with feeling like their life is trivial and insignificant. However, the Psalmist often praise God for creating them. How could Psalm 139:13-16 and Psalm 8:3-9 help you to praise God for making you?
