History Repeating Itself — Like the Days of Noah

Like the Days of Noah... one of two things will happen to the people of this world, as it applies to the permanent work of Christ in their lives.

They will either be interrupted by Him or disrupted by Him. The results of both are extraordinary but extraordinarily different at the same time.

Interruption for Instruction

Or

**Disruption for Destruction** 

Interruption for Instruction (gracious invasion)

Or

Disruption for Destruction (graceless death)

What separated Noah from everyone else in the world?

What or Who made him different?

God (He is the difference)

God Reveals (He applied that difference upon Noah with His presence which removed him from the rest)

God's Grace Removes (He replaced the gap of separation with the presence of His goodness.)

God's Goodness Replaces (He led Noah and guided him on what to do next: prepare, preach, plead and place his trust in His hands)

God's Guidance Readies and Renews

Let's think about it in the light of the sower, the seed and the soil.

The Sower and His Seed change not.

The sower and his seed: the sower sows the seed intentionally and directly on the ground that has been prepared.

## 1st Soil mentioned:

Indirectly, seed will fall upon areas that were not made ready when he broadcast his seed. Seed will indirectly fall on deaf ears.

## 2nd soil mentioned:

Seed will indirectly fall on a mind and emotions of them that take hold of what the crowd they are surrounded by grabs. They don't look within but around them and gauge the people in their circle on how they respond to it. They follow along with the crowd and mentally and emotionally are caught up in the moment. But the test will prove it wasn't personal but more of a corporate commitment and not a personal one so they will not stand on nor stand up for the word when put under pressure.

## 3rd soil mentioned:

Seed will indirectly fall on those that are savvy and well equipped with intellectual information and they will add this new information and insight to their repertoire and portfolio of options for doing life. The word becomes another means of self help tools but it just can't hold up next to all the other worldly wisdom for doing life without Jesus.

4th soil mentioned: Seed will directly and intentionally fall on the good ground that the sower had prepared and they will hear, understand, accept it as their own and see it spring up, increase and bear fruit to the glory of God. The ground is described as being a good and noble heart by Luke, unlike the hard wayside where every walks when they pass the prepared and planted field, the rockier shallow soil, and the thorny soil that's covered up and consumed that which is cursed and condemned.

Noah, being moved by the warning and word of God, by faith, built a vessel, as God instructed him, and the vessel he constructed had NO rudder, NO sails and NO anchor. Don't miss this... it applies to us trusting Jesus

with our lives. No rudder, no sails and no anchors means no control... no control MEANS he submitted and surrendered himself and all that he had to God. This means that Noah placed his entire life in the hands of Him, who would take him and the only means of safety, in a world flooded with judgement, wherever God chose. And God did just that... He took Noah wherever He wanted and protected him from His wrath and judgements.

He lived, built, preached, thrived, led, loved and floated by faith upon the word of God and His promised mercy. We're not building an ark but we are colaborers with Him building the kingdom for Him and the family of God. The utter opposite is so for the world that has not been interrupted by Him. What happened to the rest of the world that rejected the message and manifestation of the truth that Noah preached and demonstrated while building that ark? God DISRUPTED for Destruction the world Noah lived in. That world lived as usual, doing life the way they normally did life, unmoved and unaffected by the message, until the rain started... and that wrath and judgement of God DISRUPTED their agenda with that

which followed — destruction. But Noah and those with him were all interrupted to be invaded with God's everlasting grace.

So Jesus is either going to interrupt to invade or disrupt to destroy... I'm grateful for His interruption and invasion upon my life today. Now, I'm called on by God to join Him and my brothers to warn this world and build His kingdom with the tools and treasures His provided for every good work. Interrupted or disrupted... which will it be?
