The danger of making greed your creed

- 1) Disciples should never trust in money as a **Savior** v. 16-21.
- 2) Disciples should trust God and share knowing that it **pleases God** to give us the kingdom both now and forever v.22-34. Failure to trust God will produce three by-products:
 - a. **Worry** (v.22-25)
 - b. **Anxiety** (v.26-31)
 - *c.* **Fear** (v.33-34)
- 3) Disciples serve while waiting **expectantly** for the return of the Master v.35-40.
 - a. Worrying about wealth will make our spiritual **lamps go out** V.35.
 - b. Worrying about wealth will distract us from living with **anticipation**. V.36-40.
- 4) Disciples are **stewards** of God's possessions and are to use them to bless others v.41-48.
 - a. When our possessions begin to possess us we will **abuse people** to get more possessions.
 - b. When possessions become priority we will live as if Jesus will **never return**.
- 5) Disciples are mistaken if they think the way they administer their possessions will **please everyone** v.49-53.
- 6) Disciples know what time it is v.54-59.

Jesus comments in v.13-15 say it all.

- I have neither come as financial <u>arbitrator</u> nor to guarantee that your perception of <u>fairness</u> is always met! Jesus did not come to guarantee that life would be <u>fair</u> on earth. He came to guarantee that life could be <u>forever</u> in heaven.
- The problems in your life do not have a **monetary solution**.
- Abundance doesn't = **happiness**.
